T.R.I.B.E. DISTANCE-LEARNING PROGRAMME

WHAT IS T.R.I.B.E.?

T.R.I.B.E. is the name of the distance learning programme of the Native Bible Centre. The letters stand for **TRAINING RESOURCES FOR INDIGENOUS BIBLE EDUCATION.**

It is the purpose of the Native Bible Centre to assist believer and churches by providing Biblical resources that can be used to learn the Word of God. The T.R.I.B.E. programme is designed to give general Bible knowledge along with practical ministry skills for the believer.

The courses are divided into four categories:

- 1. Chronological Courses
- 2. Topical Courses
- 3. Practical Courses
- 4. Elective Courses

A student may take the courses for credit. The programme requires completion of fifteen courses from the Chronological, Topical and Practical categories. A Bible certificate is awarded upon completion of the first five. A second certificate is awarded upon the completion of an additional five. When the student has completed fifteen courses, a Bible diploma is awarded. If taking TRIBE courses for a diploma, the Chronological courses must be completed in sequence, as each one builds on the previous one as they go through the Bible. If not working towards a diploma, a student may take the courses in any order. Three courses from category four (Elective Courses) may be substituted for any three courses in categories two or three.

ONLINE BIBLE COURSES

Native Bible Centre courses are now available for printing off the NBC website — www.nativebiblecentre.org. Just choose *Courses* and follow the links to the course you would like to print off in pdf format. There is no charge for these downloads. For the Assignments or Tests in the course, the student can scan them and email them to Native Bible Centre or Fax them to us. The \$5.00 credit charge can be sent by snail mail. If the student does not wish to work toward a diploma, just print the Bible Study you would like to work through on your own. We are available to help you, whether it is via email, fax or the toll-free number.

HOW TO EARN CREDIT FOR T.R.I.B.E. SELF-STUDY COURSES

- 1. Complete an application/registration form (at the end of this catalogue)
- 2. Purchase the workbook (\$12.00 for most of the courses) and pay the credit fee

(\$5.00) for each course.

- 3. Complete assignments and/or quizzes in the course for your own review. Send these to NBC only if instructed to in the course. Complete the tests in the course and send them to NBC for grading.
- 5. Earn a passing grade (The final grade is usually an average of the grades from assignments, quizzes and tests).

What Do Students Say About T.R.I.B.E. Courses?


- *The Big Picture* put into order where each book of the Bible fits. It helped me make sense of the Bible and keep straight God's order of things.
- *In the Beginning* showed me how God set up things in the Old Testament to point to Jesus and His death on the cross.
- The course *Powerful Preaching* taught me the difference between *concrete* thinking and *abstract* thinking. *Concrete* thinking is something you can touch like trees or people. *Abstract* is like sin or forgiveness there are no pictures for these things. The Old Testament is concrete teaching. The books of Romans through Ephesians in the New Testament are *abstract*. To preach clearly, I need to explain *abstract* things in a *concrete* way.
- One of the greatest lessons I learned from *In the Beginning* is that God is holy and because of my nature of sin I cannot go directly to God. I need someone to go to God for me, on my behalf, like a priest. Jesus is that Someone He is my priest.




- After taking the course *The Big Picture*, I now have a clearer understanding of how and why Israel is important in the Old and New Testaments.
- In *Spirit World* I learned the four principles for defeating Satan:

Rely on God's power, always be on the alert, put on the armor of God and always pray.

■ The main thing I learned in the course *Chief People* is that the Israelites were sinful. Animal sacrifices were offered each year for the forgiveness of sins. But then Jesus Christ took over for those offerings. He is the Chief Priest and the ultimate sacrifice. Man can only come to God through Him.


